Our efforts are headed to recipients in Veterans' homes, Project Linus, MEND (Meeting Essential Needs with Dignity), Jersey Battered Women's Shelter, Mrs. Wilson's House, Ocean Medical and Jersey Shore (hospitals in central Jersey) and Quilts for Kids (in PA). During the months when no one was accepting quilts for donations, we have continued to gather supplies, cut, sew, and quilt - preparing for the day when sites will once again open up. Slowly but surely we are making progress!

Emily reports that along with 85 quilts that central Jersey has donated to Sunshine in 2020, there are 43 additional quilts donated so far in 2021. She also passed along 30 comfort pillows for distribution to hospitalized patients.

Thank you for your contributions this year. We are looking forward to getting together for more bees as soon as we can do so safely. Keep stitching during these long winter months; spring is around the corner!


Block of the Month

We still need money for extra fabric, batting, backing, binding and quilting, so please include \$5 for your first 1-2 blocks, \$3 additional for each block after your second. DO NOT SEND CHECKS. From the artist.....

Azulejos started out as a block with 5 randomly placed lines in a square. The lines became shashing to separate the shapes. With bright colored wedges outlined in grey on a white background, the block looked like a Portuguese ceramic tile or azulejo. Each block is the same layout, some square as the original, others rotated, stretched and or mirrored. With repetition and manipulation, the possibilities are endless.
