

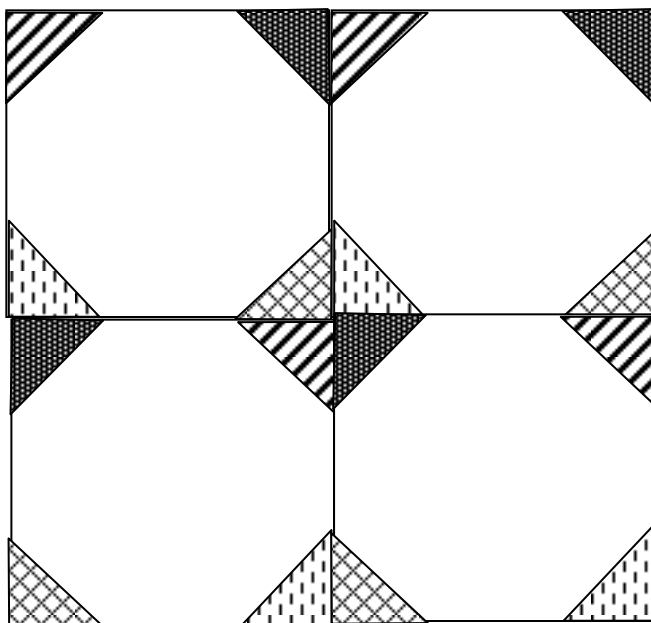


Garden State Quilters Guild Sunshine Committee

Snowball Pattern

Makes a 36" x 42" Quilt (6 x 7 snowballs)

1. Cut the 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips provided into 42 - 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
2. Cut the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips into 84 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and further cut on the diagonal into triangles ("half-square triangles").
3. Overlay a different triangle on each corner of the square, right sides together. Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam along the cut diagonal. Trim corner of square to $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Iron.
4. Attach squares, mingling the colors in a pleasing arrangement, into 7 rows of six.



Fabric requirements:

7 strips 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide full fabric width

5 strips 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide full fabric width

Approximately

1 $\frac{1}{3}$ yd snowball main fabrics

0.5 yd corner fabrics

To get better distribution of fabrics, may want to mix half widths to have 14 different snowball and 10 different triangle fabrics.
