Message from our President

Turning Lemons into Lemonade

Sometimes in spite of our best efforts, our projects don't quite turn out the way we envisioned. At other times, we just can't move forward. Here are some suggestions for turning those "lemons" into "lemonade."

- When you have orphan blocks that don't quite fit into your quilt, turn them into Little Wishes for the quilt show.
- When the sixteen points in the center of your star don't quite meet, applique a circle over them.
- When the fabrics in your quilt are not working well together, replace the ones that are the least cooperative and save them for another project.
- When you are unhappy with the block you made in a workshop, try doing it over in a different palate.
- When you are stuck in a rut with your current project, put it aside for a while. When you come back to it, you may have figured out what you needed to know.
- When you haven't been quilting for a while and don't know how to get back into it again, make a simple quilt for Sunshine. You may just trigger your creative juices or, at least, help cheer up someone in need.
- When you are frustrated and have questions about a project, go to a quilting bee and ask someone to help you move forward.
- When you are feeling uninspired, come to a guild lecture or sign-up for a workshop. You may learn something that will forever change the way you make guilts.
- When you are starting a new quilt and need some inspiration, go shopping in your stash or check out the Drop and Shop Marketplace. You may find a fabric that jump starts your creativity.
