- Any of these: Partially pieced or unfinished tops, orphan blocks from exchanges, block of the month, or vintage blocks you don't know what to do with. Leftover squares and strips of any color or size. Experiments that didn't work, blocks that didn't fit, or you thought were just plain ugly. You get the picture!
- 2 yards or more TOTAL of assorted strips or fat/skinny eighths, quarters, or 6" wide strips in wide range of colors and values. lights/mediums/darks/stripes//commercial, hand-dyes, batiks. (Solids and black & white patterns are especially useful).
- a 24 x 36 piece of 100% cotton batting to use as a design wall
- blue painter's tape to put up batting on wall
- Sewing machine, thread
- Rotary cutter & mat
- Scissors, seam ripper
- Sewing machine
- Neutral thread
- Iron
- Ruler
